

# **Sixth amendment to the General Bathing Conditions of the City of Weißenfels on the use of the outdoor pool and the indoor swimming pool**

of 22 February 1996 (WSF OJ No. No 2/1996, p. 9), amended on 24 July 1998 (WSF OJ No. No 7/1998, p. 6), amended on 11 December 2001 (WSF OJ No. No 1/2002, p. 8), amended on 05 February 2002 (WSF OJ No. No 3/2002, p. 5) and amended on 11 May 2005 (WSF OJ No. No. 5/2005, p. 10), again made public with corrections in the WSF OJ. No 6/2005, p. 7.; amended on 23 March 2016 (WSF-ABI- No. 4/2016, p. 17)

## **I. Terms of Use**

### **1. Use of the swimming pool**

1.1. The use of the swimming pool is carried out against payment of a fee, which is specified in the fee table.

Every user has to buy a ticket before entering the swimming-pool, which entitles him to use the swimming-pool once (day ticket) or several times (permanent ticket) depending on the type of admission ticket. The ticket is not transferable to third parties.

Entering and leaving the swimming pool is only permitted through the main entrance.

When leaving the outdoor pool, the ticket loses its validity.

1.2. The use of the swimming pool within the framework of these General Bathing Conditions is generally permitted to everyone.

Access is not permitted for:

- (a) persons who are visibly under the influence of alcohol and who have consumed intoxication and narcotics.
- (b) persons carrying animals;
- (c) persons with contagious diseases.

Persons with skin diseases and open wounds are not allowed to use the swimming pool.

Persons with tendencies to seizures and fainting, as well as mentally handicapped or blind persons, and children under 6 years of age are only allowed to enter and stay with a responsible accompanying person.

1.3. The conditions for the use of the swimming pool by school sports are regulated on the basis of a public contract between the sports and leisure company of the city of Weißenfels and the respective school sponsor.

## **2. Opening hours**

The swimming pool has fixed opening hours. They are determined by the management of the sports and leisure company of the city of Weißenfels, announced to the local press and displayed visibly in the entrance to the swimming pool. By decision of the management of the sports & leisure company of the city of Weißenfels, it is possible to deviate temporarily from the published opening hours.

## **3. Behaviour rules in the swimming pool**

3.1. Every user shall behave in such a way that decency as well as safety, cleanliness and order in the swimming pool are guaranteed and other users are not unreasonably disturbed or harassed.

3.2. Every user is obliged to treat all facilities and equipment with care.

3.3. Any found damage or contamination of the facilities and equipment of the swimming pool has to be notified to the staff.

3.4. In order to avoid accidents, it is not permitted to:

- submerge other users, bump into a swimming pool or harass them through sports exercises and games,
- playing ball around the rescue tower of the outdoor pool (within 15 meters)

Jumping from the starting block/jumping board is allowed at your own risk.

Anyone who enters or leaves the swimming pools other than via the planned stairs and ladders acts at their own risk.

The blocking of the diving tower as well as instructions by the staff must be observed and adhered to.

It is not allowed to jump from the platform with start run. The jumpers have to remove themselves immediately after the jump from the jumping area. Swimming and diving in the diving area is not allowed.

Non-swimmers may only use the swimming pool for swimming training under the guidance of a swimming instructor.

The use of the slide is only permitted after approval by the staff and is at your own risk. Every user must make sure in advance that the immersion area is free.

The use of the water playground and playground is at your own risk.

3.5. For hygienic reasons, the following requirements must be observed:

- staying in the swimming pools is only permitted with usual swimwear,
- spitting in the swimming pool and in the bathroom is not permitted,

- eating in the swimming pools is not allowed.
- every user must use the through pools before entering the normal swimming pools.

### 3.6. Prohibited Items

All visitors are prohibited from carrying the following items:

- weapons of any kind,
- items that can be used as a weapon,
- gas spray bottles, corrosive or colouring substances or pressure vessels for highly flammable gases, excluding commercially available pocket lighters,
- pyrotechnic material such as fireworks, Bengali fires, smoke bombs, smoke powder, sparklers, etc.,
- fire-hazardous objects, poles (except required walking aids) etc.,
- mechanically or electrically operated noise instruments (e.g. megaphone, fanfares),
- posters and other objects that serve any demonstration of opinion (e.g. racist, xenophobic, radical right, Nazi or political propaganda material),
- bulky items as well as ladders, stools, chairs, boxes, etc.
- laser pointers, trill pipes,
- flag and transparent poles
- large banners (max. 1 m<sup>2</sup>), larger quantities of paper, rolls of wallpaper, confetti, etc.,
- drugs within the meaning of the Narcotics Act (BtMG),
- animals of any kind.

### 3.7 Noise nuisances

Users are not allowed to use musical instruments, mobile phones or sound reproduction stools if this leads to harassment of the other users.

### 3.8. Smoking

Smoking is only allowed in the outdoor pool outside the changing, sanitary and bathing area. Ashtrays provided for this purpose must be used. The lawns must be kept free of cigarette residues.

### 3.9. Photographing

Photographing and filming of other persons and groups without their consent is not permitted. Photographing is completely prohibited in the area of the swimming pools.

For commercial purposes and for the press, photographing and filming requires the prior approval of the management.

The provisions of the General Data Protection Regulation must be observed.

#### **4. Additional services**

Any user may use gaming and sports equipment for the period specified in the pay table against payment of a fee according to the pay table.

#### **5. Parking**

The parking of vehicles is only permitted in the designated places.

#### **6. Supervision of compliance with the General Bathing Conditions**

6.1. Swimming pool staff shall be authorised to make the necessary arrangements for the maintenance of safety and order and for compliance with the provisions of these General Bathing Conditions. Every user must comply immediately with the instructions of the staff.

6.2. The swimming pool staff is authorised to expel users from the swimming pool area if they:

- endanger, disturb or violate security and order,
- harass other users,
- despite admonishment, disregard the provisions of these General Bathing Conditions.

There is no entitlement to a refund of the entrance fee in these cases.

Anyone who does not follow the instructions of the staff to leave the bath must expect a complaint for breach of house peace. In this case, the bath staff may arrange for the bathing guest concerned to be removed from the bath with the assistance of the police.

6.3. In the case of repeated violations of the provisions of these General Bathing Conditions, the management of the sports and leisure company of the city of Weißenfels may exclude users from using the swimming pool for up to one year.

#### **7. Findings**

Found objects must be handed over to the staff for forwarding to the municipal lost property office (Einwohnermeldeamt).

#### **8. Liability**

8.1. Users shall use the swimming pools, including their facilities, at their own risk.

8.2. The operator is only liable for personal, material or financial damage within the scope of the statutory provisions.

8.3. For the loss or damage of the equipment provided for temporary use in accordance with para. 4., the swimming pool guest must pay full compensation for the replacement.

The loss and damage of these devices must be reported to the staff immediately.
